### Information and Conditions of entry for individual Students

The Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. invites all Primary School Children in the North and North East, to compete in a Lego Competition running in the first term of 2026.

### For schools or community groups with less than 12 participating students

all students to enter into the same age group, with only one overall winners mediation awarded.

---

### For schools or community groups with more than 12 participating students. There are 4x age groups

(With a least 3 students per age group)

- **Kinder -Prep:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 1-2:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 3-4:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- **Grades 5-6:** winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)



**Your school or community group then must pick 1 overall winner from your age group winners, to represent your school this year.**

Your School's or community group's overall winner will receive 1x "Age Group & Overall" winners' medallion, plus 1x voucher for a Leven River Cruise, 1x free pass to Beaconsfield Heritage Museum, Richmond Gaol and a free family pass to Brixhibition Launceston 2026.

Each Primary School or community group can determine their own Lego challenge winner with the following rules and conditions.

- Each Lego display to be no larger than 52cm wide, 52cm deep, 52cm high, or no larger than four 32x32 lug Lego baseplates.
- Each Lego display must be an original or freelance design, and not made from a Lego kit or instructions.
- Some minor Adult help is allowed, but the Lego design should mainly be child's own design.
- Each School or community group to confirm their participation no later than **Friday 20th February 2026**
- Each Lego entry to be completed and displayed at your local school or community group "in house" or "virtually", by no later than **Monday 23rd March 2026**.
- Each Primary School's or community group's overall winner must be determined and announced by no later than **Friday 27th March 2026**.
- Schools and community groups can choose to undertake their own judging by photos (virtual) or in-house (as previous years)
- Each Schools Lego Challenge overall winner then will be invited to compete against other schools overall winners.
- All Brixhibition Kids Comp overall winners, will be invited to showcase their winning Lego Models at the Brixhibition event, and participate in the "Grand Competition" to be judged by Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. members at the Brixhibition event Sat 2<sup>rd</sup> & Sun 3<sup>rd</sup> May at the Launceston Conference Centre (Door of Hope Complex)
- Grand Prize winners will be announced at the Brixhibition Launceston 2026 event on Sunday 2<sup>rd</sup> May at 3:20pm.
